UPDATED MASK MANDATE

New Mexico Department of Health has adopted the current CDC guidelines on face masks; therefore, at Southwest Motorsport events fully vaccinated individuals are no longer required to wear a face mask or social distance.

It is each members responsibility to select the appropriate course of action as it pertains to themselves and their vaccination status.

Thank you to you all for being so good about the mask wearing all this time. Your respect of the policy has helped us keep the members safe during this pandemic.

<u>Recommendations</u> for <u>unvaccinated</u> persons attending Southwest Motorsport events

- Masks encouraged at all times and in all indoor spaces or when within 6 feet of another person outdoors
- No attendance if you are experiencing any symptom of illness such as cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell.
- If you have traveled to a highly impacted area within the United States of America in the last 10 days, NM State guidance encourages self quarantining and testing.
- Do not attend if you believe you have been exposed to someone with a suspected and/or confirmed case of the Coronavirus/COVID-19
- Do not attend if you have been diagnosed with Coronavirus/Covid-19 and not yet cleared as non-contagious by state or local public health authorities
- Socially distance at the drivers meeting or corner workers meeting in the pits
- Radios will be sanitized before distribution each day
- One worker per station
- Tower Personnel limited to 3 personnel. Timing and scoring, Race Control and Race Steward
- On track sessions may be a lead follow format at the discretion of the instructors in the cars
